## The Design Brief

## Objective

To create artwork that aligns with the theme of 'The Neurodiverse Brain' for Arden University's Brain Awareness Week ("the Theme").

Your artwork should either be:

- 1. An original painting; or
- 2. An original sculpture; or
- 3. An original picture (landscape or portrait) or
- 4. An original video clip that is no longer than 30 seconds; or
- 5. An original audio track that is no longer than 120 seconds.

There will be 3 categories that we will judge each artwork submission against; please see clause 4.2 of the Terms and Conditions for more details.

You must also submit along with your artwork, a supporting blurb (no more than 200 words) explaining how your artwork fits the Theme ("Artwork Explanation").

Your artwork and Artwork Explanation must not include:

- 1. anything of a distressing or age-sensitive nature; and
- 2. any flashing lights or anything that could trigger epilepsy in viewers of the artwork.
