Frequently asked questions

What time should I arrive?

We recommend you arrive approximately 1½ hours prior to the start time of your ceremony. This will give you time to register, collect your guest ticket/s, collect your gown, have your official photographs taken and take your seats.

What happens when I arrive?

Graduates make your way to the registration area, this will be situated in the Westminster Foyer/Lower Ground Floor. There will be an attended cloakroom on Level 1 where you can leave your belongings. There are lifts to all levels and toilets are available on each floor. If you do require any special assistance, please let a member of our team know as soon as possible and we will be happy to assist.

Ticket Collection

All graduates need to register on arrival. The registration and ticket collection desk will be situated in the Westminster Foyer/Lower Ground Floor. Your allocated seat number will be printed on your envelope so please keep this safe. Extra guest tickets may be available to purchase at the Help Desk in the Westminster Foyer/Lower Ground Floor with card payment only and are subject to availability.

Academic Dress

Once you have registered you should proceed to collect your Academic Dress.

Graduation Attire will have your pre-ordered gown ready for collection in the Aldersgate/Lower Ground Floor.

Pre-paid official photography

If you have pre-ordered official photography, this will take place in Aldersgate/Lower Ground Floor after you have collected your academic dress. You will need to pre-book your packages before the ceremony, you can do this up to 10 days beforehand.

Taking your seat

All graduates and guests are asked to take their seats by 3:15pm at the latest. Graduates or guests will not be able to enter the Great Hall once the ceremony has begun. Once seated please remain in your seat for the duration of the ceremony.

Frequently asked questions

What if I am late for the ceremony?

Please make sure you are on time as you may not be able to graduate if you arrive late.

What happens during the ceremony?

Ushers will guide you to your allocated seat upon entry to the Great Hall. Staff will guide you out of your seats and up to the stage when it is your turn to graduate. After you have returned from the stage an usher will direct you back to your seat. Please do not change seats at any point as your name will not be announced in the correct order. No food or drink will be allowed in the Great Hall. Leaving early during the ceremony is strictly prohibited.

What happens at the Alumni Reception?

Following the ceremony, graduates and guests are invited to attend the Alumni Reception in the Library-Lecture Hall/Level 1. Keep your ticket and exchange it for a complimentary drink whilst celebrating with your fellow graduates, guests, and Arden academics. There will be a merchandise stand where you will be able to purchase a variety of Arden-branded goods. There will also be a careers stand, where you will be able to chat with one of our experienced Career's Team members.

Where do I return my gown?

Drop off points for your academic robes will be in the Library-Lecture Hall, Level 1, and must be returned no later than 6:00pm.
