

The Alumni reception won't open until the ceremony has ended and will last for approximately 1 hour.



# About Central Hall Westminster

The wonderful location in which we are joining each other for today's graduation ceremony is Central Hall Westminster, a Grade II listed building which we hope you'll agree is a fitting location to celebrate your academic achievements.

Originally opened in 1912 as a space for worship, concerts, and public and private events, Central Hall Westminster is one of the capital's most culturally significant venues. Over the years it has welcomed many noteworthy public figures through its doors, including Martin Luther King, Mahatma Gandhi, and King Charles III, and was also the location of the Inaugural Meeting of the United Nations in 1946.

The Great Hall's breathtaking grand organ, which you'll see located behind the stage as you await your graduation moment, features 4,731 pipes; and don't forget to look up – the spectacular self-supporting domed roof above you is the largest of it's type in Europe.

We hope that attending your graduation day in such a beautiful setting will create memories that last a lifetime.





# The history of the ceremonial mace

The tradition of the mace derives from medieval times in England when the mace was held by a bodyguard for dignitaries at ceremonial functions.

As an ancient symbol of authority, it reminds us that universities are custodians of both enduring traditions in learning and of the power they bestow upon those who come to learn.

The mace has become a symbol of authority and character of the institution and is carried at the head of the robed academic procession, followed by academic staff from the schools and faculties whose students are to be presented.



### About the Arden University mace

Our beautiful mace was designed by Arden University Graphic Design student Jemma Lee Loppnow and crafted by the world-famous silversmiths Thomas Fattorini Ltd in Birmingham, England.

The creative and modern design represents a modern university and is symbolic of Arden University's proud history and values.

The symbolic Arden 'A' is held by supporting hands and the bird holding the scroll in its beak represents offering education to all. The globe at the bottom of the staff represents opportunities for a higher education around the world.

# Arden University Honorary Doctorate



### Judge Charles James Phillip Gratwicke

His Honour Judge Charles James Phillip Gratwicke retired as a Circuit Judge in April 2023.

His Honour Judge Charles Gratwicke was born in Taunton Somerset in 1951. He was educated at St Bernadine's College, Buckingham and St John's College, Southsea and Leeds University 1970-1973, where he was awarded an LLB with honours. He was called to the Bar (Middle Temple) in 1974. After completing his pupillage in 1975, he joined the chambers of Anthony Cripps at 1 Harcourt Buildings, where he developed a successful general common law/criminal practice. He was appointed a part-time chairman of the Potato Marketing board disciplinary committee in 1990, and a part-time chairman of the Milk Marketing Board in 1998.

In 1998 he was called to the Bar in Bermuda to conduct Drug Prosecutions. He was appointed an Assistant Recorder in 1998, a Recorder in 2000 and a Circuit Judge in 2003. He served as the Resident Judge at Chelmsford Crown Court from 2012 to 2020 and was the Honorary Recorder of Chelmsford from 2013 to 2023. He was a travelling murder judge for three years up to his retirement in 2023. He continues to sit as a judge in retirement at the Central Criminal Court (the Old Bailey) and Southwark Crown Court.

Judge Gratwicke is the founding Chair of the Arden University Law School Advisory Board, where he offers support and advice to the Law School faculty, students, and management of Arden University. Over his career, Judge Gratwicke has had a particular interest in legal education and speaking at colleges and universities to students aspiring to become lawyers.


