Arden University Honorary Doctorate

Markus Kreßler



Markus Kreßler is a social entrepreneur and systems-oriented innovator whose work over the past decade has focused on expanding access to high-quality education and creating sustainable pathways into employment for underserved and displaced communities.

He is best known as the co-founder of Kiron Open Higher Education, a pioneering digital education initiative founded in 2015 to enable refugees and migrants to begin or continue university-level studies regardless of legal status, documentation, or prior access to formal education. Under his leadership, Kiron developed one of Europe's leading blended-learning models for displaced learners, combining scalable online education, academic partnerships, and structured transitions into the labour market. The initiative has supported tens of thousands of learners and helped shape wider debates on digital pedagogy, inclusion, and technology's role in reducing structural barriers in education.

Alongside Kiron, Markus has worked at the intersection of education, technology, and employability. Through collaborations with partners such as Lingoda, he contributed to initiatives that translate learning into concrete labour-market access for international talent, including the co-founding of the MatchTalent initiative. His work consistently emphasises system-level solutions that move beyond individual support to address structural challenges through responsible, scalable, technology-enabled approaches.

Markus studied Psychology at the University of Mannheim before pursuing an interdisciplinary academic path in Berlin, spanning psychology, business and technology, and creative disciplines. This background enables him to bridge human-centred perspectives with technological innovation and institutional design.

Earlier in his career, Markus gained experience in management consulting and helped found several civic and social initiatives, including early digital volunteering platforms, sustainability-focused cooperatives, and education-driven organisations. His contributions to social entrepreneurship and educational innovation have been recognised through national and international awards.

Looking ahead, Markus views his work as part of a broader mission to help create societies in which everyone has a genuine opportunity to develop their full potential. He believes that technology, when embedded in responsible systems and guided by human-centred values, can help build fair, sustainable, and inclusive futures.


